

E1: Lightroom Practice Exercise**Shooting Requirements:**

- Shoot in Camera RAW
- Shoot in Manual Exposure Mode
- Bracket your exposures (N, N+1, N-1).
- Shoot 3 different scenes. Have your main subject in focus.
- Shoot a WB device shot for each scene
- That is 12 shots total. Please do not shoot more for this exercise.

Adobe Lightroom Requirements:

- On your Hard-drive, create a folder called "206 LR Photos". Use this to store all photos in this class.
- Create a new LR catalog. Call it "mtruitt_LR_206" (use your first initial last name)
- Import your 12 exposures.
 - Have them go into a new sub folder called "206 E1" in your "206 LR Photos" folder (Library).
- Follow directions on LR Workflow Handout and use:
 - 0 RAW ORG (originals) collection
 - 1 Picks (go to contact sheet)
 - 2 Selects (Highest Rated (3 Stars and Higher), Plan To Edit)
 - 3 DNG Edits - Blue
 - 4 PSD Edits - Purple
- Make a contact sheet in LR as shown in class
- Save Contact Sheet as JPEG.
- Make a Virtual Copy of one file from Selects, and Edit in Develop Menu
 - Apply WB correction
 - Make color edit and BW edit
